## ORDINANCE NO. 103

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TRANSFER OF MONIES FROM THE AMBULANCE FUND TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, TO THE GENERAL FUND OF SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That from and after the date of this Ordinance the Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, may, at any time from the date hereof, transfer any surplus money from the Ambulance Fund of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, into the General Fund of the said City, at such time as the said Council of said City shall deem necessary and proper.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
