## ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE PRUETT ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A subdivision of a track of land beginning at the Southwest corner of the SW/4, SW/4, NW/4 of Section 26,; thence North 0 degrees 09' East, 245.00 feet to the true point of beginning; thence South 89 degrees 51' East, 89.87 feet to the West line of Highway No. 59; thence North 17 degrees 50' West, 290.83 feet; thence South 0 degrees 09' West, 276.60 feet to the true point of beginning; and the West 1.00 foot of the South 245.00 feet of the SW/4, SW/4, NW/4 of Section 26; and the West 1.00 foot of the North 1,980.00 feet of the SW/4 of Section 26; and the South 1.00 foot of the West 1, 034.00 feet of the SW/4, SW/4 of Section 26; and a strip of land 1.00 foot wide lying East of the following described line: beginning at the Southwest corner of the SW/4, SW/4, NW/4 of Section 26; thence North O degrees 09' East, 245.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 51' East, 89.87 feet to the true point of beginning; thence Southeasterly along the West line of Highway No. 59 the South line of Section 26; all in Township 16 North, Range 25 East, Adair County, Oklahoma,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **PRUETT ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are hereby changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
