## ORDINANCE NO. 118

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR VACATING AN ALLEYWAY IN BLOCK 37 IN THE ORGINAL TOWN OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1.That, Whereas the Bank of Commerce of Stilwell, Oklahoma, is the owner of property described as Lots 13, 14, 15 and 16 in Block 37, and, whereas the Bank of Commerce is desirous of razing certain structure on the aforedescribed property for the purpose of placing thereon improvements to the aforementioned Bank of Commerce and parking area, and, whereas the Bank of Commerce has presented to the Council and Mayor of this City a Waiver of Objection, signed by all property owners in Block 37, consenting to the closing of the East-West alleyway that abuts upon lots 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 in said Block 37, and, whereas the Mayor and Council of this City have determined that it would be to the benefit of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of this City to close the aforementioned alleyway running East and West in Block 37;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS DECREED that from and after the date hereof that the East-West alleyway in Block 37 in the original Town of Stilwell, Oklahoma, abutting upon Lots 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 be and the same is hereby declared to be closed and vacated.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
