ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE MARTIN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A subdivision of that portion of the W/2, NW/4, SW/4 of Section 26, Township 16 North, Range 25 East, Adair County, Oklahoma, described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of the NW/4, NW/4, SW/4 of said Section 26; thence North 0 degrees 09' East, 394.00 feet, thence South 85 degrees 20' East, 261.58 feet to the West right-of-way line of State Highway No. 50: thence South 17 degrees 50' E. along said West line, 392.58 feet; thence North 89 degrees 51' West, 190.47 feet; thence South 8 degrees 43' 19" East, 212.55 feet; thence North 89 degrees 51' West, 224.28 feet; thence North 0 degrees 09' East, 210.00 feet to the point of beginning,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the MARTIN ADDITION TO THE City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are herewith changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
