

ORDINANCE NO. 135

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE HOGNER HEIGHTS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

Beginning 300 feet East of the Northwest corner of the NW/4, SW/4; thence East 530 feet; thence South 1,000 feet; thence West 530 feet, thence North 1,000 feet to the point of beginning, being a part of the NW/4, SW/4 of Section 3, Township 15 North, Range 25 East, and

A 10 foot wide parcel of land described as being five (5) feet each side of a line described as follows, to wit: Beginning 165 feet East and 5 feet North of the Northwest corner of the NW/4, NE/4, SW/4 of Section 3, Township 15 North, Range 25 East, Adair County, Oklahoma, thence West 685 feet to the end of the parcel of land.

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made apart hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **HOGNER HEIGHTS ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are herewith changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
