## ORDINANCE NO. 143

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, AND CHANGING THE CITY'S BOUNDARY TO INCLUDE SUCH TERRITORY, AND DESIGNATING SUCH TERRITORY AS THE CARLILE HEIGHTS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That the following described real property situate adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, shall be annexed to and become part of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, to wit:

A portion of the E/2, NW/4, NE/4 of Section 27, Township 16 North, Range 25 East of the Indian Base and Meridan, Adair County, Oklahoma, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of the NW/4 of said Section; thence South 00 degrees 03' 40" West, 925.00 feet along the East line of the NW/4, NE/4 of said Section; thence North 89 degrees 56' 20" West, 295.00 feet; thence South 00 degrees 03' 40", 295.00 feet to the North right-of-way of State Highway No. 51; thence North 89 degrees 56' 20" West, 365.00 feet along the North right-of-way line of State Highway No. 51; thence North 00 degrees 03' 40" East, 1011.25 feet; thence South 89 degrees 56' 20" East, 208.75 feet; thence North 00 degrees 03' 40" East, 208.75 feet to the North line of said Section; thence South 89 degrees 56' 20" East, 32.00 feet along North line of said Section; thence South 00 degrees 03' 40" West, 208.85 feet; thence South 89 degrees 56' 20" East, 208.75 feet; thence North 00 degrees 03' 40" East, 208.75 feet to the North line of said Section; thence South 89 degrees 56' 20" East, 210.50 feet along the North line of said Section to the point or place of beginning,

a plat of which said property is attached hereto and made a part hereof as though described herein.

SECTION 2. That the real property herein described shall be designated as the **CARLILE HEIGHTS ADDITION** to the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and the boundaries of said City are herewith changed to correspond to the legal description first above given.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances or parts or ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 4. WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
