ORDINANCE NO. 163

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTERING WITH THE CITY CLERK OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA, BY ALL TRANSIT DOOR TO DOOR SALESMEN, PRIOR TO MAKING OR ATTEMPTING TO MAKE ANY SALES WITHIN THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA; AND PROVIDING A FINE THEREFOR

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

THAT from and after the passage of this Ordinance, any and all transit door to door salesmen who shall come into the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, and attempt to sell any goods, wares, contracts, subscriptions or make any sales of any kind, shall first register their names, addresses and companies they represent with the City Clerk of Stilwell, Oklahoma, before making or attempting to make any sales of the above; any person, firm or corporation who shall sell or attempt to sell any goods, wares, merchandise, contracts or subscriptions in the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma, without first registering as above set forth, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$50.00, plus costs, and each sale shall constitute a separate offense.

WHEREAS, an immediate necessity exists; therefore, for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
