WHEREAS, in order to fulfill the needs of the community, policies and regulations are necessary to provide a framework for care and safety of the citizens of the City of Stilwell; and

WHEREAS, visible and accurate house numbers are a necessary part of providing immediate knowledge of location for use by law enforcement and emergency personnel, and

WHEREAS, the responsibility for such is the lawful responsibility of the City of Stilwell,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1: Definition of Terms

1. The term "City Representative" shall refer to those persons employed by the City with authority to give citations to those not abiding by this ordinance. That shall include all police officers, Code Enforcement Officer, all City Department Heads, and any other city employee so designated by the City Council.
2. The term "City" shall refer to all areas within the confines of the City of Stilwell.
3. The term "Council" shall refer to the Council of the City of Stilwell, Oklahoma.

SECTION 2: REQUIREMENTS

1. Every owner of every building in the city shall cause the proper City Address number to be placed in an obvious and conspicuous place on the side of such building most visible from the street listed in the City Address for such building.
2. All numbers displayed as the address numbers for any building shall be no less than 4 inches (102 mm) in height and a minimum stroke width of 0.5-inch (12.7 mm) wide. These numbers shall contrast with their background. The numbers shall be of durable metal, durable wood, glass or enamel, or they may be painted of neat design and durable material on the glass of the transom of the door or other appropriate place on the building. Perishable materials, such as paper and card board, and markings of pen, pencil or other easily displaced substances shall not be deemed a compliance with this section.
3. It is the duty of owners or agents of business or residence buildings to properly and correctly number the same within 10 business days after the building is completed. Buildings removed from one lot to another shall in like manner be renumbered according to the new location within 10 business days after such removal and re-location. The owner, agent or other person making repairs or additions to buildings shall cause the number to be replaced should the repairs or improvements require temporary removal of the number.
4. When any house or building is not correctly numbered, or not numbered at all, a city representative shall give such house or building its proper number and shall notify the owner, agent or occupant to number the house correctly in accordance with this ordinance.
5. Any City Representative as defined above may award a valid citation for non-compliance of this ordinance. Such citation shall be considered a full and legal statement of violation and shall be filed with the city as such.
6. Penalty for violation of requirements stated in this ordinance shall be a 10-day grace period after citation for correction after which, should no correction occur, there will be a fine of \$50 and \$5.00 per day thereafter until compliance.
7. Any person who destroys or removes the house number of another, who obliterates, conceals, or obscures any house number, by paint or other means, is guilty of an offense, and shall be fined an amount equal to that required by non-compliance with this ordinance.
8. Exemptions and exceptions to the above require Council approval.

SECTION 3 - All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby cancelled and repealed.

3. It is the duty of owners or agents of business or residence buildings to properly and correctly number the same within 10 business days after the building is completed. Buildings removed from one lot to another shall in like manner be renumbered according to the new location within 10 business days after such removal and re-location. The owner, agent or other person making repairs or additions to buildings shall cause the number to be replaced should the repairs or improvements require temporary removal of the number.
4. When any house or building is not correctly numbered, or not numbered at all, a city representative shall give such house or building its proper number and shall notify the owner, agent or occupant to number the house correctly in accordance with this ordinance.
5. Any City Representative as defined above may award a valid citation for non-compliance of this ordinance. Such citation shall be considered a full and legal statement of violation and shall be filed with the city as such.
6. Penalty for violation of requirements stated in this ordinance shall be a 10-day grace period after citation for correction after which, should no correction occur, there will be a fine of \$50 and \$5.00 per day thereafter until compliance.
7. Any person who destroys or removes the house number of another, who obliterates, conceals, or obscures any house number, by paint or other means, is guilty of an offense, and shall be fined an amount equal to that required by non-compliance with this ordinance.
8. Exemptions and exceptions to the above require Council approval.

SECTION 3 – All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby cancelled and repealed.


