WHEREAS, in order to fulfill the needs of the community, policies and regulations are necessary to provide a framework for care and safety of the citizens of the City of Stilwell; and

County of Adair Keith Neale, of lawful age, being duly sworn and authorized says he is the Editor of the Stilwell Democrat Journal newspaper printed in the City of Stilwell, Adair County, Oklahoma, a newspaper qualified to publish legal notices, advertisements and publications as provided in Section 106 of Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes 1971 as amended, and complies with all other requirements of the laws of Oklahoma with references to legal publication. That said notice, a true copy of which is attached hereto, was published in the regular edition of said newspaper and not any supplements thereof, forconsecutive weeks:

WHEREAS, the responsibility for such is the lawful responsibility of the City of Stilwell,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STILWELL, OKLAHOMA:

The following shall replace Article 3 Section 2 of Ordinance 386 of the City of Stilwell:

Special Events License Parameters:

1. Upon the completion of an application for a special event license and approval by the City Council, a special event license may be issued to any organization, association, or nonprofit corporation, organized for political, fraternal, charitable, religious or social purposes.
2. The holder of a special event license is authorized to grant individual temporary vendor permits, for the dates indicated by the application, for the vendor locations described within the site plan on the application, as well as any vendors that rent space within two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet of the approved site plan. The special event holder shall not assess a permit fee greater than \$250.00 per day of the event to any vendor whether inside or outside the site plan of the event. Additional fees may be assessed by the special event license holder including booth space, usage fees, early setup, etc.
3. A special event license shall be valid for no more than forty-eight (48) hours before or after the date(s) indicated on the application. No special event license shall be valid for more than ten (10) days. No qualified organization may obtain more than four (4) such licenses within any calendar year.
4. It is the responsibility of the special event license holder to either report or verify the proper reporting by vendors of all applicable sales tax to the Oklahoma Sales Tax Commission. Any and all taxable sales must be verified by the special event license holder and any discrepancies in proper reporting will be solely the responsibility of the special event license holder.
5. The holder of a special event license will be required to issue temporary vendor permits in such manner as is amenable to the City of Stilwell's standard for a temporary vendor permit.
6. Event permits may be issued, sold, or distributed for the special event dates by the special event license holder. As a courtesy to the special event license holder no non-event vending shall be allowed within two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet of the approved site plan of the special event. Any and all vendors within 2,500 feet of the special event will be required to purchase a permit from the special event holder.
7. Any vendor who wishes to set up their business more than forty-eight (48) hours before or remain more than forty-eight (48) hours after the designated special event dates will be required to

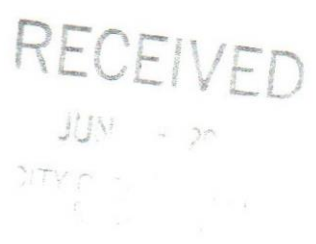

Any and all taxable sales must be verified by the special event license holder and any discrepancies in proper reporting will be solely the responsibility of the special event license holder.
5. The holder of a special event license will be required to issue temporary vendor permits in such manner as is amenable to the City of Stilwell's standard for a temporary vendor permit.

6. Event permits may be issued, sold, or distributed for the special event dates by the special event license holder. As a courtesy to the special event license holder no non-event vending shall be allowed within two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet of the approved site plan of the special event. Any and all vendors within 2,500 feet of the special event will be required to purchase a permit from the special event holder.



Any vendor who wishes to set up their business more than forty-eight (48) hours before or remain more than forty-eight (48) hours after the designated special event dates will be required to have a permit from the City of Stilwell for the amount of days they will be selling outside of the above described parameters.
